Whereas, providing The Jewish Center is a special place where all should feel comfortable and safe, and

Whereas, a need arose to enhance our fire safety and alarm system to increase coverage within our facilities, and

Whereas Andrea Russin recognized this need and stepped forward to provide a generous donation to serve this need;

Now therefore, I, Michael Feldstein, President of The Jewish Center of Princeton, do hereby proclaim and declare the appreciation of our entire congregation.

And I do further proclaim, that the 20th day of Tishrei 5770 equating to the 8th day of October 2009, coinciding with the date in 1920 when former Princeton resident, President Woodrow Wilson, declared the first National Fire Prevention Day that is now the longest public safety and health campaign in US history, shall be known as the Andrea Russin Day at The Jewish Center.
