Whereas, The Family of Edith Ales has generously and thoughtfully donated to The Jewish Center two portable ramps that can be used in multiple areas of our facility, including our bimah, to provide accessibility, and

Whereas this donation will allow meaningful participation for congregants and visitors at The Jewish Center;

Now therefore, I, Michael Feldstein, President of The Jewish Center of Princeton, do hereby proclaim and declare the appreciation of our entire congregation.

And I do further proclaim, that the 5<sup>th</sup> day of Av 5769 equating to the 26<sup>th</sup> day of July 2009, coinciding with the nineteenth anniversary of the signing of the US Americans with Disabilities Act shall be known as the Edith Ales Memorial Day at The Jewish Center.
